> Within the Future section, visitors can look forward to two special features: 'Made in Taiwan Young Artist Discovery', which spotlights young local talents under 35 years old, and 'Bad Painting' by Pow Martinez, who intentionally twists portraits and breaks down city scenery to challenge traditional concepts of form and aesthetics, presented by Silverlens Galleries. In Frontier, Singapore gallery Ikkan Art Gallery will bring a series of four single-channel video works, titled 'Fleeting Flower Series' by Japanese art group Teamlab, which combines dreamy Japanese aesthetics with cuttingedge digital technology.
